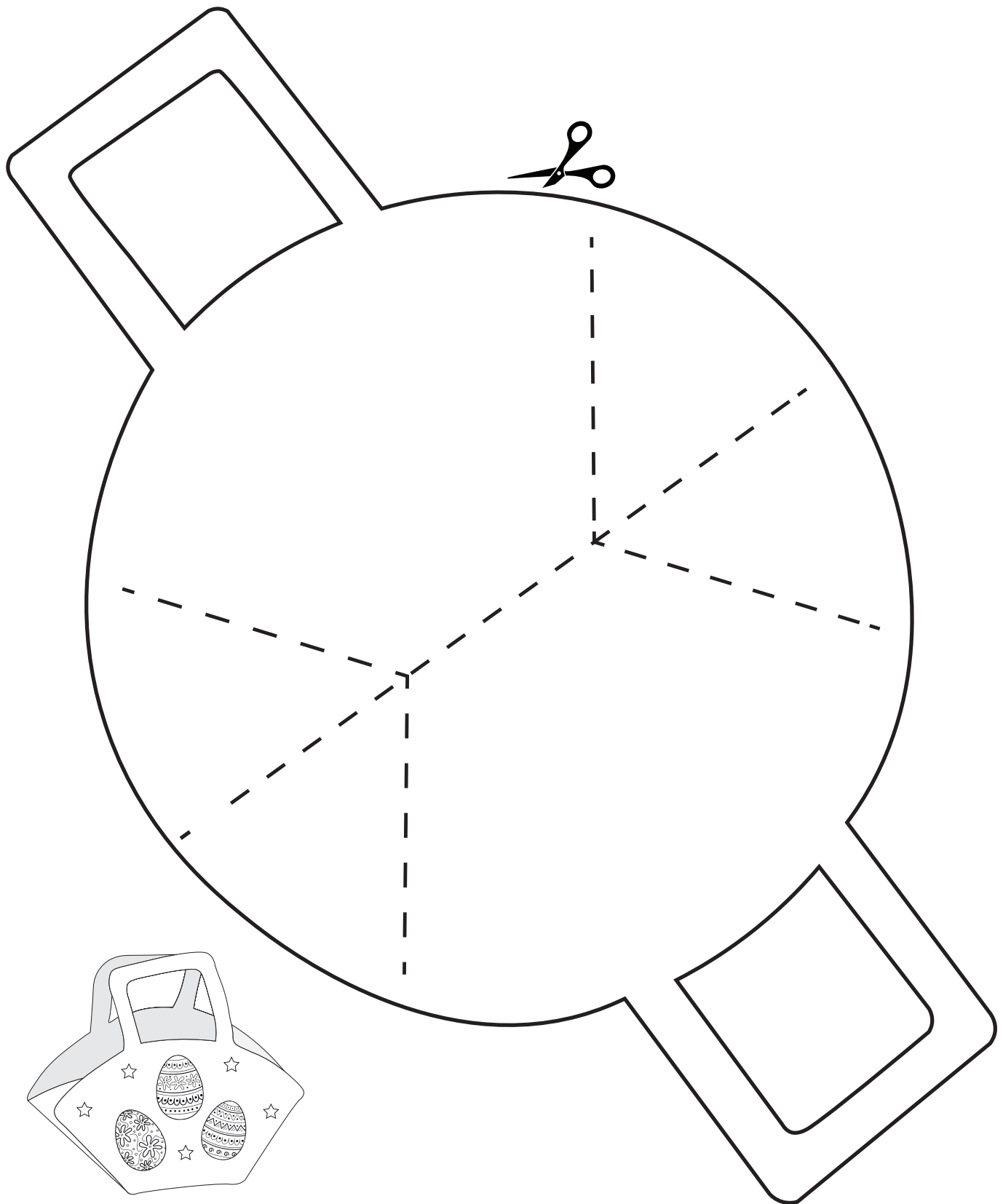


# Easter Egg Basket

# Easter Egg Basket

Ages 7+ (Adult supervision recommended)

## For this fun Easter activity, you will need:

- Coloured Paper / Plain Paper
- Scissors (use scissors under adult supervision)
- Decorations for your basket

**Step 1:** To start off, cut out the template, ensuring you cut out the little slots on the side flaps for the handles (you might need an adult's help with this).

**Step 2:** Once you have cut out your template, it should look like image 1.

**Step 3:** Make sure to then fold along all the dotted lines so that you can start to put your basket together.

**Step 4:** When you have folded them, pinch the side so that it folds inside of the basket so that it resembles image 3.

**Step 5:** Repeat step 4 for the other side of the basket.

**Step 6:** Once you get to this stage it is time to decorate your basket however, you'd like!

**Step 7:** You will then have a finished basket for your Easter eggs to sit. TIP: You can even fill them with mini eggs and hide these in your Easter egg hunt!
